

SEQUENCE OF EXAMINATION

MOBILE PHONES/SMART WATCHES/ELECTRONIC DEVICES ARE PROHIBITED IN TESTING AREAS. CANDIDATES FOUND IN POSSESSION OF MOBILE PHONES/ELECTRONIC DEVICES SHALL BE DEBARRED PERMANENTLY

19. **Physical Fitness Test (PFT).** PFT consists of a 1.6 Km run to be completed within 7 minutes (For candidates up to the age of 21 Years) and 7 minutes 30 Seconds (For candidates above 21 years of age and holding Diploma / B.Sc in Pharmacy). In addition, Candidates will have to complete 10 push-ups, 10 sit-ups and 20 squats within the stipulated time to qualify in the Physical Fitness Test.

Note: Candidates are advised to bring their sports shoes and shorts/track pant. Detailed procedure on expected technique for Push Ups, Sit Ups and Squats is available on CASB web portal www.aimenselection.cdac.in.

20. **Written Test.** All candidates who qualify PFT shall undertake Written Test on the same day. The Written Test will be objective type and question paper shall be bilingual (English & Hindi) except for English paper. Answers are to be annotated on OMR sheet. Detailed procedure shall be explained before conduct of the examination. Duration of the written test will be 45 minutes and shall comprise of English (20 questions) as per 10+2 CBSE syllabus and Reasoning & General Awareness (RAGA) (30 questions). CANDIDATES ARE TO QUALIFY IN EACH PAPER SEPARATELY. Results of the written test shall be declared on the same day.

Marking Pattern for Written Test (Objective):-

- 01 mark for every correct answer.
- Nil (0) marks for un-attempted question.
- 0.25 marks shall be deducted for each wrong answer or choosing more than one option as answer.

21. **Adaptability Test-II.** All candidates who pass the Written Test will have to undertake Adaptability Test-II on the same or subsequent day depending on the local conditions. Adaptability Test-II is to select candidates who can adapt to the environment of Indian Air Force and are able to adjust to the Military way of life.

Note: The question paper is a confidential document of Indian Air Force. All candidates are to note and understand that access to the question paper is permitted only during the examination. Question paper in any form whatsoever will not be provided to the candidate after examination.

22. **Medical Examination.** Candidates who qualify Adaptability Test-II shall be medically examined in the month of July 2024 at SMC, Air Force Station Ambala. Medical Examination shall be conducted by Air Force Medical Team as per IAF medical standards and policy in vogue on subject issue. Medical examination would also include baseline investigation as follows:-

- Blood Haemogram - Hb, TLC, DLC
- Urine RE/ME
- Biochemistry
 - Blood Sugar Fasting & PP
 - Serum Cholesterol
 - Urea, Uric acid, Creatinine
 - LFT- Serum Bilirubin, SGOT, SGPT
- X- Ray chest (PA view)
- ECG (R)
- Any other test necessary in the opinion of the Medical Officer.

Candidates declared medically unfit can avail the option for 'Appeal Medical Board' (AMB) against their unfitness by depositing Rs. 40/- in a Government Treasury/RBI/SBI through Electronic Military Receivable Order/ Military Receivable Order (e-MRO/ MRO). The application for AMB along with original copy of e-MRO/MRO, photocopy of Unfitness Certificate are to be submitted to the representative of 1 ASC, AF within three working days of medical examination. AMB Centre will be SMC, Air Force Station Chandigarh.

Note-1. Candidates are advised to get tartar & stains removed from their teeth before appearing for the medical examination. Ears should be free of wax. Candidates should be prepared to stay for the medical test for four to five days under their own arrangement. **No TA/DA shall be admissible.**

Note-2. Request for change of Medical Examination Centre and date of Medical examination shall not be entertained.

23. The Recruitment Medical Officer and the specialist doctors of Armed Forces are the final authorities on declaring a candidate Fit or Unfit during initial medical examination, Appeal Medical Board and Medical Examination prior to enrolment. The candidates shall be governed by Armed Forces standards which may be at variance from civil standards. There is no provision for representation or review after the Appeal Medical Board.

24. **Registration Fee.** Registration fee of Rs. 100/- plus GST is to be paid online by the candidate while registering for the Recruitment Rally. The payment can be made by Debit Cards/Credit Cards/Internet Banking/UPI through payment gateway. Candidates are advised to follow the instructions/steps given on the payment gateway, and also print/keep transaction details for their records.

25. **Refund Of Multiple Payments:** If multiple payments are received from a candidate against single application, then that will be refunded back to the originating account after closing of registration and re-conciliation of all payment records. However, if candidate is found to have filled multiple applications, only one application will be accepted and the amount with respect to other applications not considered for recruitment process will not be refunded. Fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances and shall not be kept in reserve for any other examination or selection.

GENERAL

26. General Instructions for candidates are as follows:-

- The candidates should carry their AADHAAR Card as proof of identity whenever they report for the Selection Test and Medical Test. Candidates from J&K, Ladakh, Assam and Meghalaya who are fulfilling the domicile requirement and eligible to appear in recruitment rally, are to carry any other valid photo ID Proof, if Aadhaar Card is not available.
- Candidates should be prepared to stay for the entire duration of the tests under their own arrangement. **No TA/DA shall be admissible.**
- Candidates are required to provide an active e-mail ID and mobile number at the time of online registration. This e-mail ID and mobile number will be used by CASB for all communications till culmination of the entire selection process and enrolment for the particular intake. It is also advised to preserve e-mail ID and password for all future communications.
- Duplicate/Incomplete/Erroneously filled applications shall be rejected.
- Candidature of candidates who applied more than once in response to this advertisement and obtain different registration numbers shall be rejected.

27. **Publishing of PSL.** The Provisional Select List (PSL) will be displayed at 1 Airmen Selection Centre, Ambala Cantt (Haryana) on 11 November 2024 (Separate PSL will be published for Diploma / B.Sc in Pharmacy holders). Display list will also be available at Central Airmen Selection Board web portal www.aimenselection.cdac.in. The inclusion of names of the candidates in the PSL depends upon the performance of the candidates in the rally. **INCLUSION OF NAME IN THE PSL DOES NOT GUARANTEE AUTOMATIC ENROLMENT.** Enrolment is strictly in order of merit from the PSL subject to medical fitness, availability of vacancies, not exceeding the age of 21 years for candidates with 10+2 / Intermediate / Equivalent including vocational course and 24 Years for candidates holding Diploma / B.Sc in Pharmacy, on date of enrolment and meeting other laid down eligibility criteria as and when called for enrolment. The validity of PSL shall be six months from the date of display and shall be applicable only for Airmen Intake 01/2025.

28. If any such candidate absents himself or expresses unwillingness to join IAF or his candidature gets cancelled due to any reason in the trade in which he was called for enrolment, then the candidate shall be marked as absent/unwilling/candidature cancelled in all other PSLs for Airmen Intake published on the same date wherever his name figures.

29. **ENROLMENT LIST.** List of candidates finally called for enrolment for AIRMEN INTAKE 01/2025 will be published on 28 November 2024. Call letter shall be sent to candidates called for enrolment on their e-mail IDs provided at the time of registration.

30. If there is any variation between English & Hindi/any other regional language versions of the advertisement, English version shall be taken as authentic.
